## Indonesian Coal

In case South African coal is not available then a quantity of 10,000MT–40,000 MT is required per month as per following specifications:

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## Terms and Conditions

(1)	<b><u>Payments on FOR Supplies.</u></b> Will be made through Local Revolving, 30 days Ussance LC as under:-
(a)	<b><u>Freight Charges.</u></b> Will be paid within 48 hours of Receiving Report which is prepared within 48 hours after receipt of coal.
(b)	<b><u>Cost of Material.</u></b> Supplies will be accepted in packets of 2500-3000 MT.90% of the cost of 2500 - 3000 MT ( $\pm$ 10%) coal will be paid on 30th day of Penalty /Premium Certificate.
(c)	<b><u>Balance Payment.</u></b> Balance 10% amount will be paid after 30 days on successful completion of PO.
(2)	<b><u>Payments on CNF Supplies.</u></b> LC at sight / Ussance LC as mutually agreed between both parties
(3)	<b><u>Lab Test.</u></b> Lab test of QC FCCL will be considered as final if FOR supplies. In case of CNF supplies, lab test will be mutually agreed between both parties.
(4)	<b><u>Weight.</u></b> The weight measured at FCCL Weigh Bridge will be considered as final.
(5)	<b><u>Formulae for Penalties/Premium.</u></b>
(a)	<b><u>Penalties.</u></b> As per written in above tables against each specification.
(b)	<b><u>Premium.</u></b> Will be admissible as compensation against other penalties (if levied) less sulfur.
(6)	<b><u>Quantity.</u></b> Minimum 10,000 – 40,000 MT as and when tendered.
(7)	<b><u>Rates of Coal.</u></b> As per offered quality.
